
These Trial Licence Terms govern your evaluation of Shearwater Transcriber during the 7-day trial period. By installing or launching the Software, the Evaluator agrees to these terms.

Definitions

"Software" means Shearwater Transcriber and the Shearwater AI Engine in any version supplied by the Licensor. "Licensor" means J & K Bradley Reporting Pty Ltd ATF Topcat Discretionary Services Trust (ABN 71 908 010 981), trading as CalGen.AI. "Evaluator" means the individual or organisation downloading and using the Software for evaluation under these terms.

Grant of Trial Licence

2.1 The Licensor grants the Evaluator a personal, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable licence to install and use the Software on a single machine for evaluation purposes only, for a period of seven (7) days from first launch.

2.2 Transcripts produced during the trial must not be relied upon as final professional deliverables without independent verification. The trial is intended for evaluation; it is not a permanent substitute for a paid licence.

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Restrictions

3.1 The Evaluator must not reverse-engineer, decompile, or attempt to derive the source code of the Software, except to the extent permitted by mandatory law.

3.2 The Evaluator must not redistribute, sublicense, or transfer the Software or any licence key.

3.3 The Evaluator must not remove or modify any proprietary notices in the Software.

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Trial Period and Expiry

4.1 The trial period is seven (7) days from the date the Software is first launched.

4.2 At the end of the trial period, the Software will suspend. To continue, purchase an annual licence at <https://bradleyreporting.ai>.

4.3 Trial extension requests may be submitted to jasonbradley@captify.live and are granted at the Licensor's sole discretion.

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Single Machine

The trial licence permits installation and use on a single machine only and may not be transferred or activated on additional machines. The paid annual licence permits use on two machines (e.g., desktop and laptop) under one key.

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Privacy and Data

6.1 The Software processes all audio and transcript data locally on the Evaluator's machine. No audio or transcript content is transmitted to the Licensor or any third party.

6.2 The Licensor collects the Evaluator's name, email address, and business name solely for providing the trial and communicating about the Software, in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) and the Australian Privacy Principles.

6.3 The Licensor will not sell or share the Evaluator's personal information with any third party except as required by law.

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Termination

The Licensor may terminate this trial licence immediately if the Evaluator breaches any of these terms. Upon termination, the Evaluator must cease all use and delete all copies.

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Governing Law

These Trial Licence Terms are governed by the laws of Queensland, Australia.

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Australian Consumer Law

Nothing in these terms excludes, restricts, or modifies any right or remedy implied or imposed by the Australian Consumer Law that cannot lawfully be excluded.

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Full Licence
